SNAP INCOME LIMITS

For the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), one of the changes that must be reported is when the household's total monthly income, before taxes and deductions, is more than the monthly income limit for their household size. This monthly income limit changes each October.

You must report this change within 10 days of when you know of the change. You may do this by contacting the Public Assistance office by phone, email, or in writing.

The change reporting rules are different for the Alaska Temporary Assistance, Adult Public Assistance, and all Medicaid programs. If you have any questions about what you need to report, please contact your local office.
