

For children, Denali KidCare is issued for 12 months at a time. You will need to renew your application every 12 months to ensure there is not a break in coverage.

## What services are covered?

- ◆ Doctor visits
- ◆ Health check-ups & screenings
- ◆ Vision exams & eyeglasses
- ◆ Dental check-ups, cleanings & fillings
- ◆ Hearing tests & hearing aids
- ◆ Speech therapy
- ◆ Physical therapy
- ◆ Mental health therapy

### Who is eligible?

Generally, you may be eligible if:

- You are age 18 or younger; or
- You are pregnant; and
- You live in Alaska, and
- Your family income meets the guidelines.

### What if my children already have health insurance?

This program is primarily for individuals without health insurance. However, if your family income is quite low, your children with health insurance may still be eligible for Denali KidCare. You must declare current health insurance on the application.

### Do assets count for eligibility?

No. Your family car, house, and other property assets do not affect your eligibility.
