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General Information about Denali KidCare

Who is eligible?

Generally, you may be eligible if:

- You are age 18 or younger; or
- You are pregnant; and
- You live in Alaska, and
- Your family income meets the guidelines.

How do I apply for my children or myself?

No. Your family car, house, and other
property assets do not affect your
eligibility.
