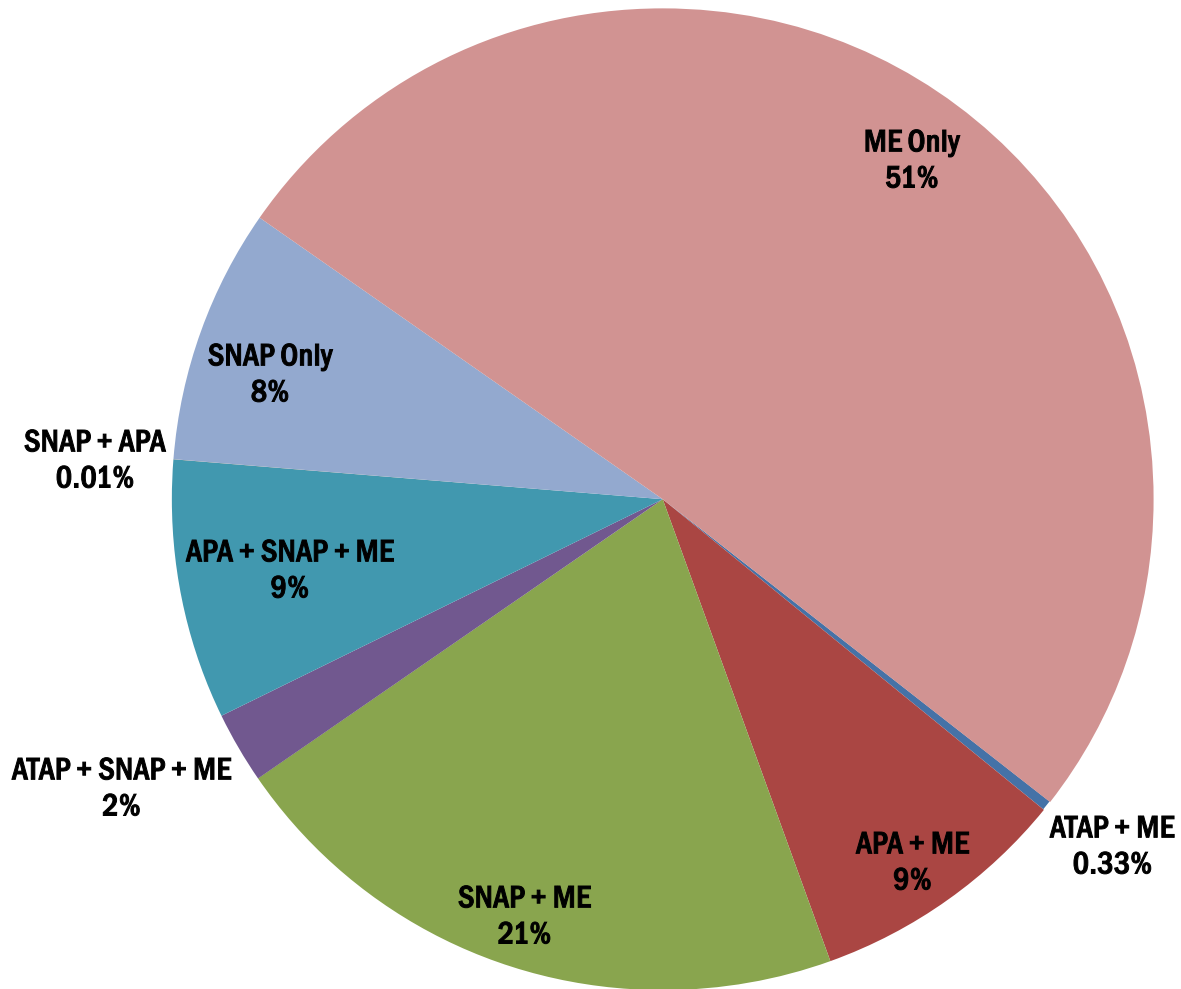

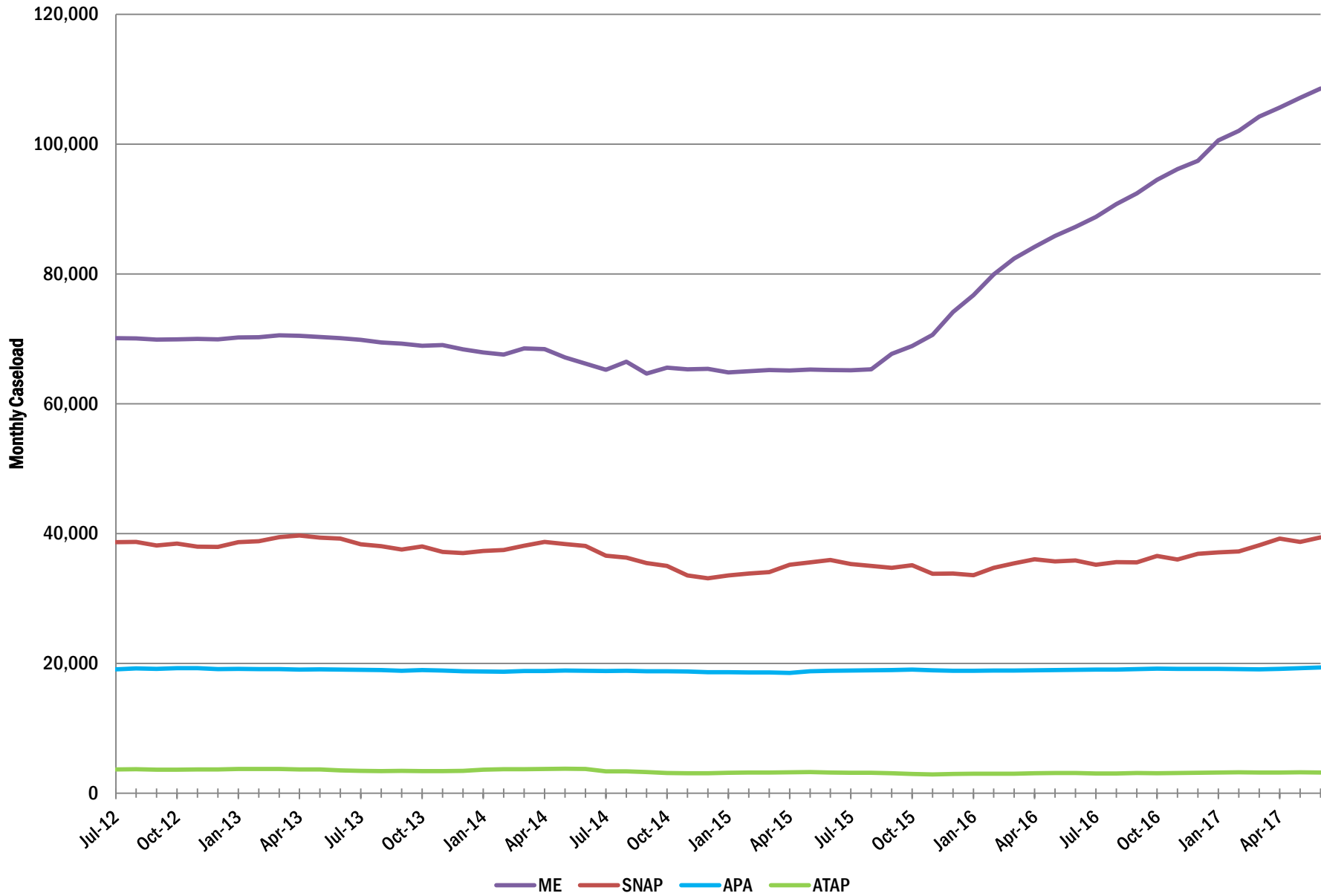
### Households Receiving Multiple Programs SFY17 Monthly Average



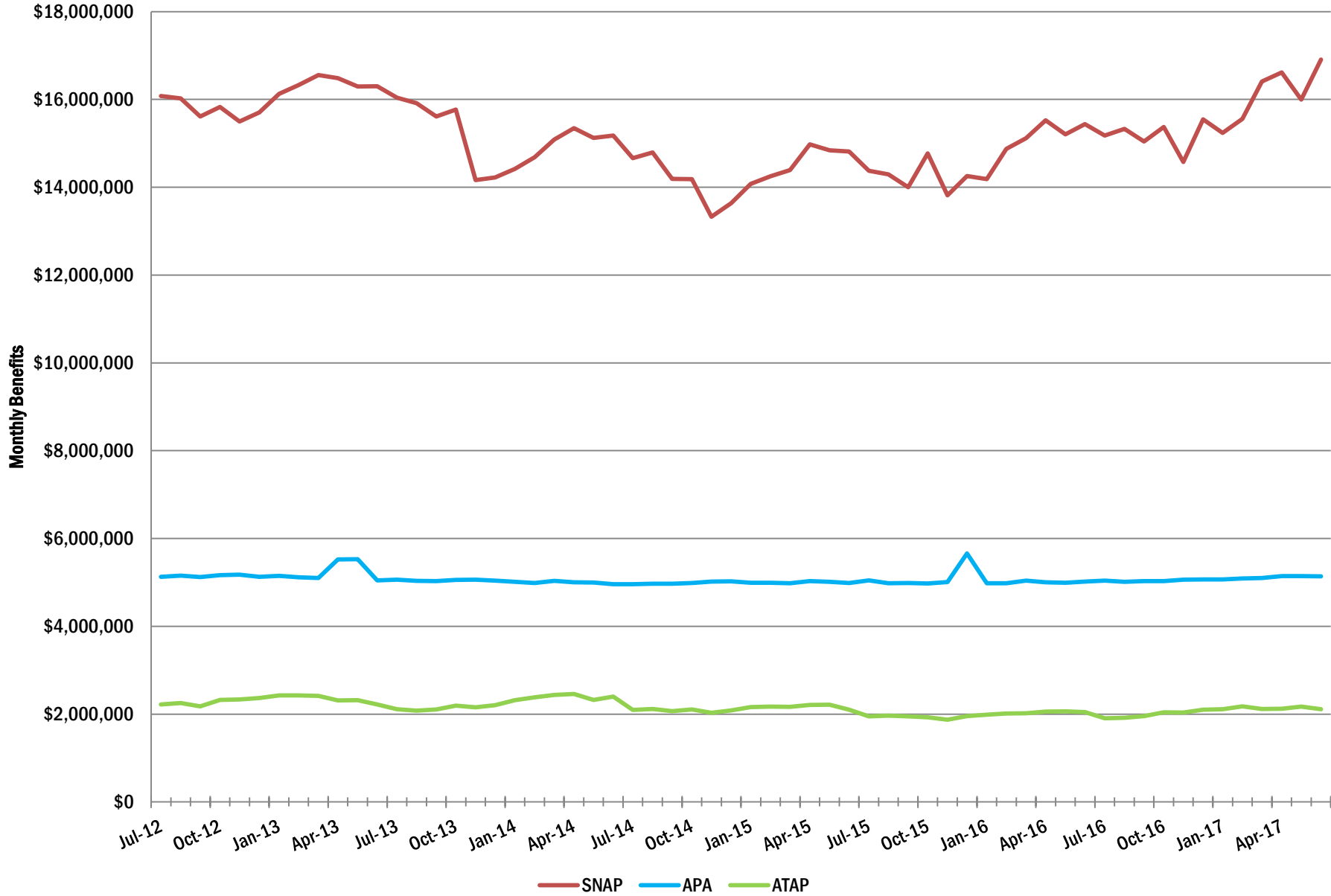

### DPA Benefits History





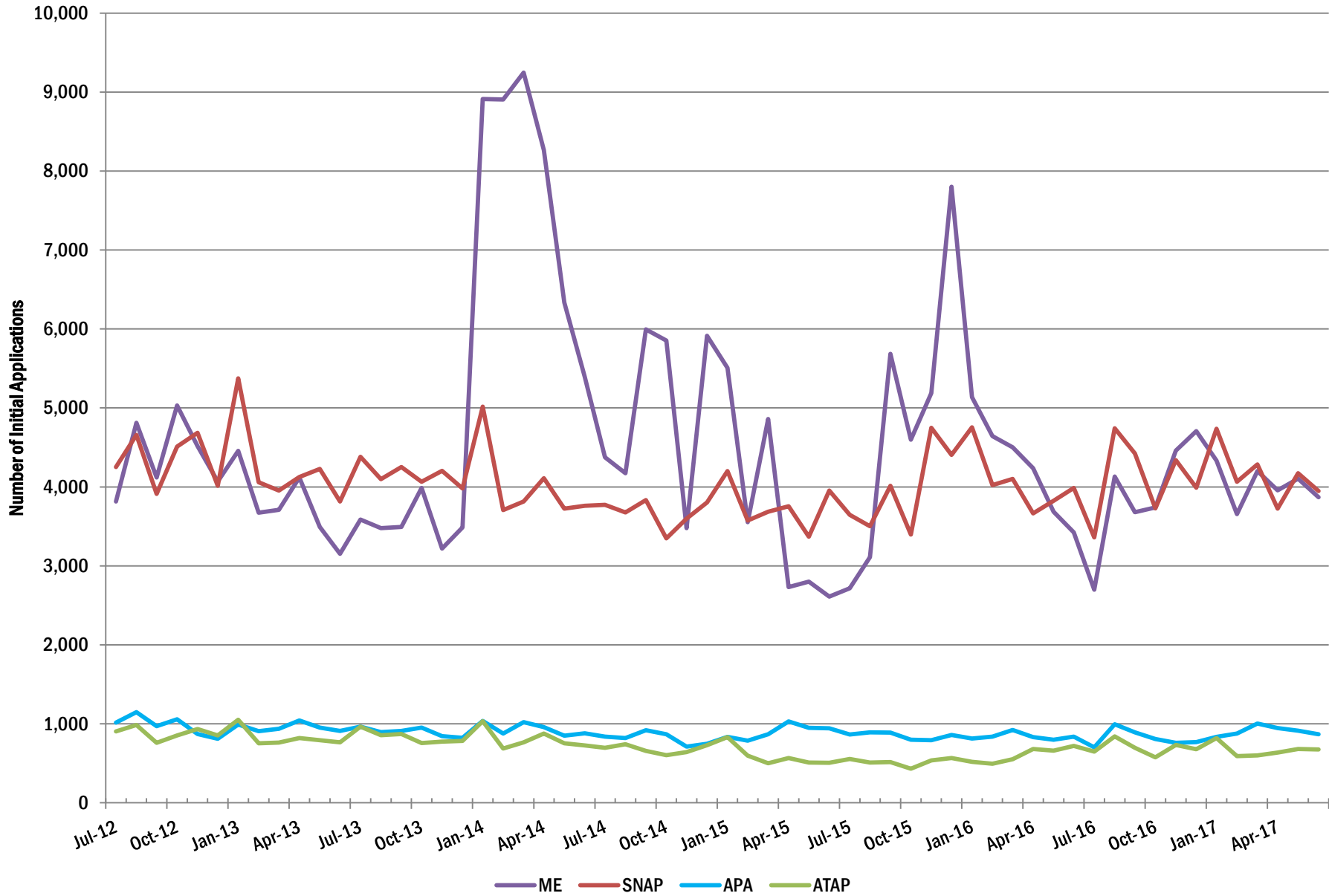
